

Battery test AIR3-7.3x

- Your IMEI:
- Install the latest AIR³ Manager and XCTrack. USE [AIR³ Upgrader](#) to have all your apps up to date.
- Launch AIR³ Manager, reset XCTrack interface to have the default interface. More details here: <https://www.fly-air3.com/en/support/air3-xctrack-manual/air3-manager-manual/#Reset>
- Deactivate the adaptive brightness in Settings/Display and **set the brightness in the system to 80%**
- Launch XCTrack and check the percentage of brightness in the bottom left. (The Brightness of the display widget is installed with the latest configuration). If the brightness is not 80%, use the Brightness "+" widget available in the "thermal assistant page, by clicking on the upper half" to increase the brightness up to 80%.
- Make sure it is fully charged by minimum **6 hours of charge with a >= 2A charger** (without taking into account if it has already reached 100%).
- With XCTrack active, write down the battery percentage that should be 100% and the time. Set a timer to warn you every hour so that you can easily see and write down the percentage every hour while the unit is active. Make sure to write down both the percentage and the exact time. Always check that the brightness percentage is 80%).

Once you have reached 5% or less. Charge it again for minimum 6 hours even if you have already reached 100% quicker and do the test a second and a third time. Send the results once done.

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Charging
